UNIFORM CODE
2022-2023

General

Guidelines: Students are expected to be dressed appropriately for the school day. Uniforms are expected to be worn on a daily basis, unless permission is given by administration. Accessories, jewelry, hairstyles, etc. are allowed, but must not be disruptive or outside the scope of Christian decorum. Students must wear tennis shoes that are safe for recess and gym class on regular uniform days. Dress shoes are only required with the formal uniform. All skirts and shorts may not be more than two-inches above the knee.

General Uniform (Grades K-8):

BOYS

1. Navy blue pants or navy blue shorts
2. Hunter Green polo shirt
3. Brown or black belt if the shorts or pants have belt loops. This is only required for 1st-8th.
4. Tennis shoes only for general uniform days.

GIRLS (Grades K-8):

1. Navy blue pants, navy blue shorts, navy blue jumper, or navy blue skirts/skorts
2. Hunter Green polo shirt
3. Brown or black belt if the shorts or pants have belt loops. This is only required for 1st-8th.
4. Tennis shoes only for general uniform days.

Formal Uniform (Grades K-8):

GIRLS

1. K-4-Plaid jumper (Hunter/Classic Navy plaid from Lands' End only)
2. 5-8-Plaid skirt (Hunter/Classic Navy plaid from Lands' End only)
3. Long or short-sleeved white button-down shirt
4. Navy blue cross tie (from Lands' End)
5. White, black, or navy blue socks OR tights
6. Black or brown dress shoes. This does not include boots.

BOYS

1. Navy blue pants must be worn November 1-March 31
2. Navy blue shorts may be worn August-October 31 and April 1-June
3. Long or short-sleeved white button-down shirt
4. Plaid tie (Hunter/Classic Navy plaid from Lands' End only)
5. White, black, or navy blue socks
6. Black or brown dress shoes

Accessories:

1. Optional navy or hunter green cardigan, sweater, sweater vest, or official St. Patrick School sweatshirt sold through the school are allowed in the classroom.
2. St. Patrick Catholic School t-shirt may only be worn to school on Tuesdays, unless permission is given for a special occasion. This shirt must be worn with proper uniform bottoms.

Consequences:

1. If a child is out of proper uniform they will receive a level II and parents must bring in proper uniform pieces to make sure they are following the uniform policy.
